## Tropical tree frog found in bananas

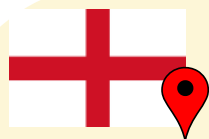
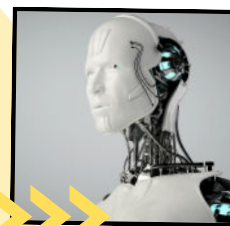

## Robots could do your chores (but you'll have to wait 10 years!)

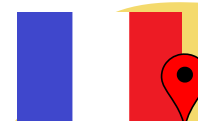
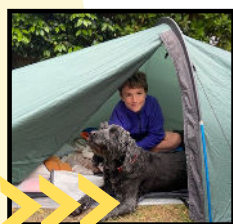
