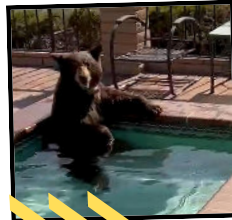

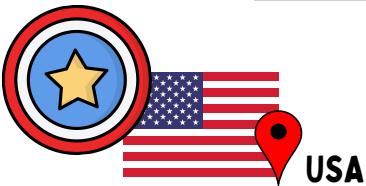
## Boy camps in garden for charity
